

GETTING TO YOUR ADVENTURE: BEN NEVIS

Wondering how to get to your adventure with us? We've put together some more information and tips for getting your destination. If you have any specific questions then please don't hesitate to get in touch.

The trip starts on the first day at 10:00 at Fort William train station. It's not always the easiest place to get to so some people like to travel up before to get there.

By Train:

If you are traveling by train, Fort William Train Station is on the West Highland Line. Trains run from Glasgow Queen Street station to Mallaig, and Fort William is one of the stops along the route. Check the train schedule and book your tickets in advance.

By Car:

If you are driving, Fort William is accessible by the A82 road, which runs through the town. Use a navigation system or maps to guide you to Fort William. The town is well-signposted from major roads.

By Bus:

Fort William is served by long-distance bus services from various locations in Scotland. You can check with bus companies for schedules and routes.

By Air:

The nearest major airport is Glasgow International Airport (GLA). From the airport, you can take a train or bus to Fort William.
