# GETTING TO YOUR ADVENTURE: GRAND TOUR DES COMBINS



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Wondering how to get to your adventure with us? We've put together some more information and tips for getting your destination. If you have a specific questions then please don't hesitate to get in touch.

**Geneva** is the closest airport to access to the **Grand Tour des Combins**, (we recommend using Sky Scanner to help plan your flights).

We've chosen **Mauvoisin** as the starting point for our itineraries, though there are several other options including:

- **La Fouly**
- **Bourg-Saint-Pierre**
- **Great St. Bernard Pass**
- **Saint-Rhémy-en-Bosses.**

To make your journey smoother, we recommend **spending the night in Le Châble** before beginning the trek. There is also a hotel in Mauvoisin if you'd prefer to be at the trail head. If you'd like assistance with **pre- or post-trek accommodation**, feel free to reach out—we're happy to help with bookings.

## GETTING TO LE CHABLE

**By Public Transport from Geneva Airport**

- Take an **SBB train** from **Geneva to Martigny** (approx. **1h 45m**).
- From Martigny, take the **regional train to Le Châble** (approx. **35m**).

## GETTING TO MAUVOISIN

**Bus from Le Châble** will take you to **Mauvoisin** (approx. **45m**).

*You can plan your journey here.* (Start Point: Le Chable VS, Finish Point: Mauvoisin)
